PULL FLOWER “PIN THE TAIL ON THE BUNNY”

- Print the Little B “Pin the Tail on the Bunny” PDF pattern on white-coated 8-1/2 x 11-inch cardstock.
- *Note: Print shops have and can Xerox on coated cardstock. Inkjet may smear*
- *Tip: The Foil Tapes stick well onto coated or slick papers.*
- Cut along the **straight vertical** dotted line, leaving a rectangle shape around the bunny.
- *Note: You will apply the Specialty Foil Tapes to the **blank white backside** of the bunny.*
- With the blank white side of the rectangle facing **UP**, begin applying strips of Foil Tape in a diagonal pattern across the entire rectangle – extending at least to the outside edge of the rectangle. It is OK to have tape extend over the edges.
- Continue applying strips of Foil Tape in a diagonal pattern until the entire white rectangle is covered. Make sure that each piece of Foil Tape is sticking to the white-coated cardstock - Do not overlap the rows of Foil Tape.
- Burnish the tape strips in place on the cardstock by rubbing a soft cloth quickly over the strips while applying a bit of pressure.

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PULL FLOWER “PIN THE TAIL ON THE BUNNY”

- Turn the Foil Tape side over so that the bunny shape is facing UP. Use scissors to cut out the bunny shape by cutting along the dotted lines around the edge of the bunny.
- Have handy your frame with a solid white backing.
- Apply adhesive over the blank side of the bunny, making sure to have adhesive close to the outside edges.
- Center and adhere down the Foil Tape Bunny onto the white backing paper in the frame.
- *Note: Leave the glass off the frame to be able to add the dimensional “Pull Flower Bunny Tail” and to use the frame as a Home Décor accent.*
- *Idea: You could put the frame glass over the flat Foil Tape Bunny to play “Pin the Tail on the Bunny” – that way the “Pull Flower Bunny Tails” can stick to the glass and not mar the Foil Tape Bunny.*
- *Note: What a fun use of Specialty Foil Tapes for Home Décor and Games!*

HOW TO MAKE A LITTLE B™ PULL FLOWER

- Unroll the Pull Flower fabric strip and cut to your desired length. The longer you make the strip, the fuller your flower will be. (24 inches was used for each of the flowers pictured here.)
- Fold the Pull Flower strip in half.
- Pull the two strings to gather the fabric strip into a fast, simple and beautiful flower.
- Tie the strings with one or two square knots to secure. Trim off any excess string.
- To create “Pull Flower Bunny Tail” game pieces, use the Scallop Circle Punch and punch out a “My Bunny Tail” from the printed PDF pattern. Write the player’s name on the scallop circle. Attach the punched scallop circle to the back of a Pull Flower for a flat surface “Bunny Tail” game piece. Repeat to create a variety of colors and styles of Pull Flowers.
- Play “Pin the Tail on the Bunny” by adding an adhesive dot to the backside of the scallop circle. Place a blind fold over each player’s eyes – spin him or her around a few times while singing “Here comes Peter Pull Flower Tail – Hopping Down the Bunny Trail – Hippety, Hoppity, Easter’s on its way....” Give the player his or her “Bunny Tail” and see where the “Tail Ends Up”!

“YOU ARE “EGG”STRA SPECIAL!” TAG

- Cut out the “You are “Egg”stra Special!” Tag along the dotted lines with scissors.
- *Note: you want to cut off all the dotted lines.* Punch a hole in the tag at the top middle.
- Apply Gold Foil Pastel Polka Dots Tape along the bottom of the tag. Cut off excess.
- Apply Gold Foil Easter Eggs Tape just below “SPECIAL.” Cut off excess.
- Cut a 5/8 x 5-inch piece of white-coated cardstock and apply Green Herringbone Tape to the 5-inch piece.
- Use the Diamond Square Punch to cut french tails on the ends of the Green Herringbone strip of cardstock. Cut the length to be the same width as the tag.
- Add foam adhesive squares to the blank space between the two tapes on the tag. Stick the Green Herringbone strip on top of the foam adhesives.

CREATE “TAPE RIBBON” – A NEW LITTLE B™ TECHNIQUE

- Technique: “Tape Ribbon” - Cut off a 12-inch strip of Gold Foil Pastel Polka Dots Tape. Fold in half so that it sticks to itself – now you have a 6-inch long strip of “Tape Ribbon.”
- Cut the “Tape Ribbon” in half lengthwise so you have two 6-inch long strips of “Tape Ribbon”. One for now and one for later.
- Fold one of the pieces of ribbon in half and insert the loop end through the tag hole from the back to the front. Wrap the 2 loose tails from the back around to the front and through the loop. Pull the tails tight to create the Tag Tape Ribbon.
- *Note: the Foil Tape washi paper is strong and flexible, so you can pull to create a great Tag Tape Ribbon without it tearing.*
